



## Brazil

### NOTE:

#### ELIGIBILITY to apply for a Tourist Visa

- Tourism trip
- Visit to relatives or friends;
- Scientists, professors or researchers attending cultural, technological or scientific conferences, seminars or participation in artistic or amateur sport competitions, whenever no monetary prize or paid admission is involved. **(In this case, an invitation letter must be submitted)**

**Visa D Validity:** First arrival in Brazil must take place within 90 days from the date the visa was issued. This visa is good for multiple entries for the time of the visa's duration (for authorized stays of up to 90 days per visit within that period). If necessary, an extension may be obtained from the Federal Police in Brazil, if requested at least 30 days prior to its expiration, for a total stay of up to 180 days per year.

International Certificate of Vaccination indicating that polio vaccinations have been given (required for all children aged between 3 months and 6 years.)

International Certificate of Vaccination for Yellow Fever is necessary if traveling to Brazil from an infected area.

**Note: Tourist visa holders are not allowed to engage in any paid activity in Brazil.**

**U.S. Vital Documents** can assist with obtaining **U.S. Passports**, whether new issue, renewal, or obtaining additional visa pages for a valid passport.

Special requirements exist for U.S. **Official and Diplomatic** passport holders.

#### To apply for a Tourist Visa

#### Please submit the following:

Signed passport with at least 6 months remaining validity from planned date of entry and contain at least one blank visa page.

1 **Application form** per applicant, properly and completely filled in. **Note: Every applicant must complete Item 21 of the visa application form, "Comments" (Purpose of Trip).** In this section, the applicant must explain precisely what they are going to do while in Brazil.

1 recent professional **passport-type photograph**

Completed **U.S. Vital Documents Order Form** (print from browser)

Photocopy of a round trip ticket, or a signed letter by a travel agency with confirmed round trip

bookings

Minors (under 18 years old) not traveling with either parents or legal guardian(s) must provide a notarized letter of consent signed by the non-accompanying parent(s) or guardian authorizing this Consulate to issue a visa. A copy of the minor's birth certificate or, as applicable, the guardianship document, is also required.

**U.S. Vital Documents Service Fee:**\$50 per visa

**Consular Fee:**

\$110 per tourist visa

**Shipping Fee:**

\$12.00 FedEx 2nd Business Day

\$19.00 FedEx Letter (Priority Overnight)

\$30.00 FedEx Letter (Saturday Delivery)

Additional fee may apply to overseas shipping and overweight packages.

**Payment:**

Include credit card authorization or a check or money order payable to U.S. Vital Documents for Service Fee per visa, consular fee per visa, and return FedEx shipping fee.
