This booklet explains the requirements for entry to Turkey for U.S Citizens, and provides information on how to apply for a tourist or business visa. Please read this booklet carefully, before you apply for a visa. U.S Refugees are required to apply with "NON-U.S Visa Application Form".

What is a Visa?

A visa is a form issued by a visa officer. This form is placed in your passport to show that you have met the requirements for admission to Turkey. A visa may be for a single entry, for multiple entries, or for transit purposes.

The tourist visa is good for a year and allows you to stay in Turkey for 3 months in each stay (with multiple entries).

Where and When do I apply for a Visa?

U.S. citizens may obtain their tourist visas upon entry at ANY point in Turkey or from the Turkish Consulates around the U.S. However, application for a business visa must be done ahead of time, before entering Turkey.

If you need to obtain your visa ahead of time, you may directly contact a Turkish Consulate in person, or by mail. Please see the Jurisdiction List of the Turkish Consulates for your state.

What are the requirements?

The followings are the general requirements for a visa. When you apply for a business visa, a letter from the company is also required in addition to the following general requirements.

When you apply for a visa in person at the Turkish Consulates, you need the followings:

- 1- your passport (at least valid for the next three months).
- 2- a completed visa application form.
- 3- a non-refundable processing fee of \$100.

Our processing time is one-day. You may come to pick up your passport the NEXT day.

If you prefer to apply by mail or by courier service, you need to send the followings to the Turkish Consulate: (please see the Jurisdiction List of Turkish Consulates for your state).

- 1- your passport (at least valid for the next three months).
- 2- a completed visa application form.
- 3- a non-refundable \$100 money order payable to the Turkish Embassy.
- 4- a pre-paid or self-stamped return envelope

Our processing time is one-day after we receive your documents.

If you would like to get your visa upon arrival to Turkey, you will be required to have the followings:

- 1- your passport (at least valid for the next three months).
- 2- a non-refundable processing fee of \$100. (U.S. currency is accepted at the entry point.)

Please note that, business visas must be applied in the U.S.

PLEASE NOTE: U.S. citizens need to obtain a visa to enter Turkey. The passengers who do NOT leave the international airports do NOT need any visas.
